Working with the Village Administrator, the Director develops and manages a general fund budget of approximately \$5 million, and an annual capital budget exceeding \$1 million. The Finance Director supervises an Accounting Assistant, oversees the Income Tax Department and other staff performing financial tasks.

The Finance Director is a key member of the Village's management team in a financially stable organization, and reports to the Village Administrator. The Village has a AAA bond rating from S&P's Global Ratings and enjoys a healthy fund balance.

The Village is seeking an ethical and experienced professional with strong technical and interpersonal skills.
