Brookville is just west of the core of a national network of 25 interstate highways and major state routes referred to as the "Crossroads of America."

THE COMMUNITY

The City of Brookville, a "Proud and Progressive" community encompassing 3.8 square miles, is a quaint middle-class community incorporated as a municipality in 1874. Brookville takes great pride in our schools and the quality education provided to our younger residents. Brookville offers a range of activities and attractions for residents and visitors alike. With five beautiful community parks, there are plenty of places for residents to walk, bike, play, gather, and relax. The Wolf Creek Rail Trail, an 18.5-mile paved course for bikers and pedestrians, runs through the heart of Brookville.

ORGANIZATION

The City of Brookville operates under a charter known as the "Mayor-Council-Manager Plan." The Council is comprised of six members elected at large for four-year staggered terms with a directly elected Mayor who serves a four-year term and is afforded a vote on all issues. City Council appoints a City Manager who serves as the chief executive, administrative, and law enforcement officer of the City, and is responsible to the Council for the administration of all municipal affairs. The City Manager plans, organizes, and directs the overall City government, monitors the City's activities, and ensures that Council policies and directives are properly implemented and monitored.
